“In the Nature” by Keun Soon



Born and raised in Seoul, Keun Soon received classical training in traditional Korean pottery during his college and graduate studies in Korea. Drawing from a wide range of theoretical approaches, he reimagines tradition through the use of unconventional and obscure materials found in nature and everyday human life. His current collection, “In the Nature,” seeks to inspire a renewed sense of curiosity and possibility within the familiar. By transforming seemingly simple forms with unexpected textures and materials, Keun Soon challenges viewers to reconsider their understanding of nature—what it is, what it can become, and how it continues to shape human experience. 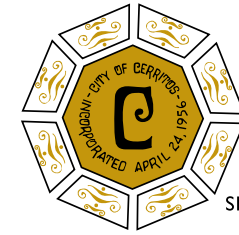
