# Cerritos Library Newsletter going digital in September

The decision to discontinue print delivery of "Library News" was made as part of the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 budget review process. To address budget constraints, the City Council on June 12, approved a recommendation to reduce select City expenses, including to end print delivery of "The Cerritos News," which includes "Library News."
